2018 Youth/Teenage Institute Bible Bowl Rules

It is our prayer that ALL Associations will participate in this year's Bible Bowl. May each of you be blessed by participating and know that regardless of the outcome, you are ALL winners!

Rules

Questions and Answers will be based on the **King James Version** of the Bible. A game will last for 20 questions OR 15 minutes, whichever comes first.

Correct or incorrect responses to questions will be determined by the judge. The judge's decision is final, and no appeals will be accepted.

I. Age Group 12-14

- Questions will be read, by the moderator, three (3) times; it is suggested that you listen to the question in its entirety the first time, before attempting to answer.
- However, you may step forward at any time the question is being read to answer; once you step forward, the question will cease to be read.
- If you answer incorrectly, the question will be re-read in its entirety for the benefit of the opposing team.

(In the case of only one team competing, the question will be re-read in its entirety for the benefit of one of the other team members).

The team with the most points, at the end of the round, will be declared the winner.

II. Age Group 15-18

- Questions will be read, by the moderator, two (2) times; it is suggested that you listen to the question in its entirety the first time, before attempting to answer.
- However, you may step forward at any time the question is being read to answer; once you step forward, the question will cease to be read.
- If you answer incorrectly, the question will be re-read in its entirety for the benefit of the opposing team.

(In the case of only one team competing, the question will be re-read in its entirety for the benefit of one of the other team members).

The team with the most points, at the end of the round, will be declared the winner.
