Participation Guidelines

The opportunities to participate in the 2010 Dr. W. O. Wells, Sr. Pageant are as follows:

CHILDREN'S RALLY

Skit (*By Any Means Necessary*), Children's Choir, Liturgical Dance and Signing

YOUTH RALLY

Drama (*In Pursuit of Healing*), Youth Choir, Liturgical Dance, Mime and Support

ATTENDANCE

In order to participate, children and youth are required to take a morning class and must attend the scheduled rehearsal times. Attendance will be monitored by designated volunteer staff. No exceptions will be made for those who wish to participate but do not attend these rehearsals barring an extreme emergency. Any congress delegates arriving by Wednesday of the congress may not participate in the 2010 pageant as part of the choir, drama and/or dance. However, provisions will be made for participation in supportive roles of the pageant (*hospitality, stage hands, etc.*)

ATTIRE

The traditional attire for the pageant is white dresses and socks or foodies for the young ladies and white shirts and dark pants, ties and dark socks for the young men (Children and Youth).

- **It is mandatory for children participating in dance to bring white gloves, white Peter pan uniform shirts and black pants or tights.**
- **Children desiring to participate in signing should bring white gloves.**
- **Youth participating in the drama are asked to bring biblical costumes for the roles they are auditioning.**
- Youth dancers are asked to bring comfortable dance attire for rehearsals and both black and white dance attire (black leotards, long skirts and footless tights) and biblical costumes for the pageant Friday night. **Dance attire is mandatory for participation in the pageant.**

We are excited churches are sending youth delegates to the Congress of Christian to take classes that provide leadership development and Christian enrichment.

Youth are expected to display appropriate behavior and adult chaperones are expected to appropriately supervise their young people. Churches are asked to help us by selecting your best as delegates and letting them know how important it is that they are on their best behavior throughout the week.

Adults selected for chaperones are reminded it is your responsibility to adequately chaperone the youth from your church. You should know where your youth are at all times and that they adhere to curfew and behavior becoming Christian young people.

Any damage caused by a delegate is the responsibility of the parent or the church. Let's remember who we are representing: God our Father.

Remember we are not here for vacation and lounging by the pool this week. We are here to study and lift the names of Jesus!
